# **Quintet Preparation Sessions**

All three works - String Quintet with Piano Reduction of Winds

**Conduct major repertoire with full orchestra in a supportive environment**. Workshop is limited to 7 participants to ensure 95 minutes of podium time over three days. Excerpts to be conducted will be chosen in consultation with workshop faculty. 40 minutes with full orchestra and 55 minutes with string quartet and piano.

### The workshop features:

- Seminars on score study, conductor/soloist collaboration, bowings, baton technique, healthy-body conducting, and organizational topics including programming and community engagement
- 60 minutes of individual video analysis and coaching with Chris Zimmerman and Kevin Sütterlin
- Receive direct feedback from orchestra members in an informal environment
- "Extravagant Hospitality" including several meals, local transportation, home stay options, more

Participant Fee: \$1200 Auditor Fee: \$150

**Participant** fee includes participation in all sessions, most meals, local transportation if needed (volunteer drivers), and optional home stay with a member of the FMSO Board of Trustees at no cost.

An unlimited number of **auditor** positions is available. Auditors may attend all workshop sessions as an observer, and the fee includes a review by the seminar leaders of submitted conducting video.
